

Associated Steel Erectors Industry Promotional Fund Education Scholarships

Description:

An education scholarship program for dependent children of full-time management employees of companies that contribute to the Industry Promotional Fund or are Regular Members of Associated Steel Erectors.

Number and Amount of Education Scholarships:

The number and amount of the education scholarships and scholarship renewals shall be established annually by the Board of Trustees of the Industry Promotional Fund. [For the year 2025, a minimum of four scholarships @ \$5,000 each have been authorized.]

Application Requirements:

All applicants must be full time students in the graduating year of high school who plan to attend an accredited college or university on a full-time basis or individuals planning to enroll full time in an accredited college or university on a full-time basis. They must also be dependent children (maximum age 26) of full-time employees of a company that contributed at least 1800 hours to the Industry Promotional Fund in the prior year, or a company that is a Regular Member of Associated Steel Erectors. The children of union employees are not eligible if they are eligible to apply to a union sponsored scholarship fund.

All applicants must submit the following:

- 1) Completed application form
- 2) School transcript showing cumulative GPA through the fall quarter/semester (including September 2024). Scoring based on cumulative GPA. The scale of A = 4.0 (adjusted for systems based on 5.0 maximum).
- 3) Essay on "What the Construction Industry Means to Me" (one page or approximately 300 words). Scoring based on title, spelling, grammar, and content.
- 4) Letter from school representative verifying participation in school activities (if indicated on application)
- 5) Letter from employer verifying employment (if indicated on application)

Award System:

All complete submissions will be reviewed by an outside judge who will recommend scholarship awards using the following point system:

•	GPA x 8	0-32 points
•	Work Activity	0-5 points
•	School Activity	0-5 points
•	Essay	0-20 points
•	ASE Member	0-5 points

In the event two or more students have the same score, the student with the highest GPA is ranked first. If there is still a tie, the student with the highest essay score would be ranked first. All decisions of the judges are final.

Schedule:

March 14: Deadline for submitting applications & related materials to the Promotional Fund

March 15: Submittals sent to judges

April 5: Judges return evaluation of applications to the Promotional Fund May 1: Promotional Fund announces winners of scholarship awards

Benefits:

The Industry Promotional Fund Education Scholarships are awarded to pay tuition, room and board, books, laboratory fees and similar expenses while attending an accredited two- or four-year college or university as a full-time student (at least 12 credit hours per semester or its equivalent).

Renewal:

Scholarships may be renewed annually depending on the budget approved by the Board of Trustees. To renew an education scholarship, recipients must complete a renewal application, continue to be full time students, and maintain at least a "C" average. A student may receive a maximum of four awards, including the initial scholarship and any additional awards/renewals thereafter.

Administration:

The Board of Trustees shall have the right to establish and amend the rules and regulations relating to the administration of the Promotional Fund Scholarship Program at its discretion.
